

TUITION WAIVER FOR COURSES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS,  
NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS & FIRE AND RESCUE VOLUNTEERS

Pursuant to New Jersey law, certain persons who otherwise meet course requirements are permitted to enroll in credit and noncredit classes at MCCC without payment of tuition, on a space-available basis, provided that tuition-paying students constitute the minimum number required to offer the course.

- 1) Senior citizens, age 65 years and older, who are residents of Mercer County. Senior citizens, age 65 years and older, who are non-residents of Mercer County may enroll with payment of tuition at the in-county rate.
- 2) National Guard members who have completed Initial Active Duty Training and are members in good standing, or the children or surviving spouse of any National Guard member killed in the performance of his/her duty, may enroll for up to twelve (12) credits per semester without payment of tuition provided that they:
  - a) Have applied for all State and Federal financial aid for which they are eligible.
  - b) Have enrolled in a program of study and are in good academic standing.
- 3) Active members of volunteer fire or first aid and rescue squads who are members in good standing, and their dependent children and spouses, may enroll in courses of up to \$300 in value per semester and \$600 in value annually, up to a maximum of \$2,400 over a four year period, provided that they
  - a) Reside in a municipality that has agreed by the enactment of a resolution to participate in the program
  - b) Maintain a 2.00 grade point average throughout the program
  - c) Execute an agreement to continue service as a volunteer for a period of at least four years

All students are required to pay for books, materials and fees in excess of tuition.
