TUITION CHARGES APPLICABLE TO NON-U.S. CITIZENS

A non-U.S. citizen who presents currently valid documentation that he or she is in one of the following categories is eligible for the same tuition rates that apply to U.S. citizens (in-county, in-state or out-of-state, depending on residence):

Immigrants*

Permanent resident

Refugee

Political asylee

Public interest parolee

Applicant for status adjustment to permanent resident

Applicant for political asylum

Employment-related non-immigrants (including documented spouses

and dependent children)

Temporary worker (INS classification H)

Intra-company transferee (L)

Religious worker (R)

International organization representative (G)

Foreign media representative (I)

Treaty trader or investor (E)

Government official (A)

Workers of extraordinary ability (INS classification O)

NAFTA professionals (INS category TN)

All other non-U.S. citizens, including foreign students attending MCCC under an F-1 student visa, are charged at the rate which applies to <u>out-of-state</u> residents.

* The normal one-year residency requirement is waived for those immigrants enrolled in ESL courses, providing that this is the only course such students are enrolled in during that semester.
