ALCOHOL ON CAMPUS

Reason for Policy

- 1. To minimize the use of alcoholic beverages on campus.
- 2. To comply with the Drug Free Schools and Communities Act.

Policy Statement

- 1. The College will not tolerate any substance use or distribution which is in violation of law or otherwise imperils the health and well being of employees, volunteers, students and guests.
- 2. Consistent with that philosophy, the College prohibits the possession, distribution, or use of illicit drugs and alcoholic beverages by any college employee, volunteer, student, guest or organization on property that is owned, operated, or maintained by the College; or at any other location as part of any college sponsored activity.
- 3. It is also forbidden by the College for individuals to be under the influence of alcoholic beverages while on college-owned property or while engaged in college- sponsored activities.
- 4. The prohibition pursuant to this policy will not apply if the person or entity serving alcohol on college owned property, at college sponsored events, or at off- campus or study abroad programs:
 - a. receives prior written authorization by the President;
 - b. meets all licensing requirements by the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control;
 - c. adheres to the provisions of all other State and municipal ordinances and regulations regarding the provision of alcoholic beverages; and
 - d. abides by U.S. Federal law regarding drug and alcohol possession and consumption.

Any employee who is found to be unlawfully manufacturing, distributing, dispensing or using a controlled substance while on college owned or operated property or while representing the college at an event shall face disciplinary action up to and including termination of employment or, if a student, expulsion from the College.
