## ROLE AND PRIVILEGES OF FACULTY EMERITI

Mercer County Community College encourages its Professors and Associate Professors Emeriti to continue close ties with the college. Those interested in part-time teaching are encouraged to seek opportunities through the appropriate division(s). As appropriate, Faculty Emeriti may be consulted as to matters affecting the institution and/or may be asked to represent the institution at academic or community functions. Upon mutual agreement, Faculty Emeriti may serve as volunteer tutors, solicitors of scholarship funds, members of scholarship selection committees, or in similar capacities.

In recognition of their status, the college affords Faculty Emeriti the following lifetime privileges:

- 1. Inclusion on appropriate lists of Mercer County Community College faculty members, with the designated emeritus rank.
- 2. A faculty identification card, parking sticker and business cards (one box) with the designated emeritus rank.
- 3. Faculty discounts, when available, at cultural and athletic events.
- 4. Invitations to major college events including Commencement, Honors Convocation, staff recognition ceremonies and holiday parties.
- 5. Free or low-cost access to a college Internet/e-mail account.
- 6. Mailed copies of appropriate college publications, as requested.
- 7. Free enrollment (for qualified Emeriti and their spouses) in credit and noncredit courses on a space-available basis.
- 8. Free access (for Emeriti and their spouses) to college recreational facilities during scheduled off-peak hours.
- 9. Reasonable access to academic facilities, office space and clerical support for approved college-related business or activity upon prior approval of appropriate divisional dean.
- 10. Reimbursement (as per standard college procedures) for reasonable expenses incurred in fulfilling approved obligations or commitments to the college. Projects involving expenditures in excess of \$500.00 must be approved in advance, in writing, by the president. The president will report annually on expenditures in this category to the Board of Trustees.
