## Completion at UMUC (60 credits):

Students following the recommended transfer course plan will need 10 credits in additional General Education coursework from UMUC, including:

- ANTH 344 or other upper-level social/behavioral science
- CMIS 111 or other second computing GenEd
- WRTG 391, 393, or 394

Students must also meet all bachelor's degree requirements including:

- Total of 120 credits for the bachelor's degree
- All required courses and the minimum number of credits for major and minor
- 30 credits at UMUC, including at least half the major and minor and 15 upper-level credits
- 45 upper-level credits, including half the credit for the major and minor
- Prerequisites for all courses taken at UMUC
